# EARSKETCH WORKSHOP

The Center for Music Technology in collaboration with the Center for Education, Integrating Mathematics, Science, and Computing (CEISM) will be hosting a professional development workshop teaching EarSketch.

EarSketch is a free, web-based STEAM learning environment that engages students by teaching introductory computer science in the context of music composition, remixing, and production.

This workshop will primarily focus on the Computer Science Principles (CSP) curriculum but is also appropriate for other introductory computing courses. Breakfast and lunch will be provided during the workshop.

\*There is **required** online prerequisite work, which should take 5 to 7 hours to complete depending on your background in Computer Science (CS).
