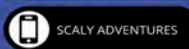
FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PLAN

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HOW DO I ACCESS TITLE ONE FUNDING FOR SCALY ADVENTURES EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS?

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Federal law requires that a school receiving Title I funds must have a Title I plan that is compatible with their Special Education Plan. Scaly Adventures® programs have special accommodations for both mainstream and self-contained SPED students.

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

Title 1 by law requires family engagement planning and programs. For STEM/STEAM Nights, Literacy Nights, Open House and other evening events, Scaly Adventures® photo opportunities are a proven huge success in encouraging students to bring the whole family to see what they experienced in school.

DETERMINE YOUR ELIGIBILITY

Every School District has a **Title One Coordinator** that can explain your school's Title One status.



NOTIFY YOUR TITLE ONE COORDINATOR

Title One schools have a **Title One Coordinator** who can help draft a **proposal** for program funding.



SUBMIT YOUR REQUEST ON TIME

Title One funding is accessible during certain times of the year and can be obtained by submitting a **written funding request**.



SCHEDULE YOUR PROGRAM

Once you have been approved for funds you **contact Scaly Adventures®** to schedule your program date.



TITLE ONE FUNDING: **TIMING IS EVERYTHING**

Getting Title 1 funding is not rocket science! Any Title 1 educator may request funds for a program or expense that will satisfy the legal requirements of the ESSA and enhance the learning opportunities for students.

The key to success is to partner with your Title 1 Coordinator to properly craft your request for funding.



PLAN & REQUEST

Each state may have their grant timeline written a little differently, so for specifics, we suggest looking for a calendar through your District Title 1 Coordinator's office or State Department of Education.



HOLD THE EVENT

Market the program to students and families. Coordinate a show schedule that best fits your school's instructional time while maximizing student experience. Finally, actively participate in the event to motivate students. Have fun!



DOCUMENT YOUR SUCCESS

Use of Title 1 funding requires follow up documentation of actions and results. The impacts of a great in-school program will help to keep these funds available for future Scaly Adventures® programs and other student activities you want to host.
